

Student Parking - Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need a parking permit to park in the DHS parking lot?

 Yes, all students who park on campus, must have a parking permit hanging in their rearview mirror.

How do I get a parking permit?

- You can get a permit during Enrollment at the start of each school year, or come into the front office at any time during the year to obtain a permit.
- Please see the "DHS Student Parking Permit Requirements" section below, to make sure you have everything that you need.

Are there a limited number of parking spaces/parking permits?

- With the expansion of our parking lot during the summer of 2020, DHS has plenty of parking spaces to accommodate the number of student drivers.
- There is no fee for your first parking permit of the school year.

Where can I park?

- Student parking is in the back (northside) of the building. Students may park in any spot that does not have a special designation.
- Students may **not** park in spots marked Handicap, Staff, Visitor or anywhere along the curb that is marked in yellow or red paint.

What happens if I get a parking ticket?

- For the 1st parking ticket earned, there is a \$5.00 fee. Your 2nd one is \$10.00. For each subsequent infraction, the fee will increase in \$5.00 increments.
- You have 1 week to pay your parking ticket. Please pay Mrs. Cahoone in the front office. You may pay with cash or a check made out to "DHS."
- If tickets aren't paid, then after school detentions will be issued.

Is there Senior Parking?

No, parking is first come first served.

What if I lose my parking permit?

• The front office can issue you a new one for \$5.00. Please see Mrs. Cahoone.

Where should my parking permit be kept in my car?

- Your parking permit must hang from your rearview mirror.
- You will get a ticket if your parking permit is not hanging from your rearview mirror.

What if I drive a different car or forget my parking permit?

- If you know you will be driving a different car to school, be sure to take your parking permit out of the car you aren't driving and place it in the car you are in.
- If you forget to put your permit in your car please come into the office or call and let us know what car you will be driving for the day to avoid receiving a ticket.

DHS Student Parking Permit Requirements

To obtain a parking permit, there are requirements that both students & parents/guardians must complete!

Please read the steps below.


STUDENT REQUIREMENTS:

- The student must be present to obtain a parking permit
- The student must have a valid Kansas Restricted Driver's License
- The student must show their current DHS Student ID
- Your parent/guardian must register the vehicles you will drive in the online Skyward Vehicle Registration form. The directions for that are below.

- 2. Go to "Online Forms" from the menu on the left-hand side

- 6. Make sure your web browser tab is opened to the full view and choose "complete vehicle registration"
- 7. Choose "form complete"
- 8. In the upper right corner of your screen it should show that your form is complete
- 9. The form must show that it has been completed before your student can receive a parking permit
