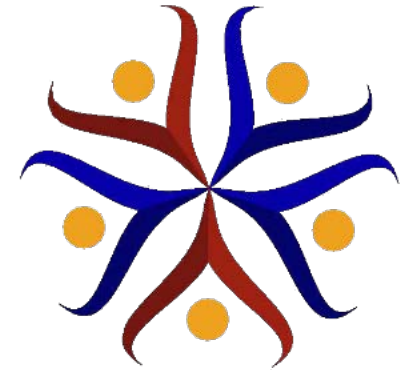

Our vision is to support students and families in fulfilling students' individual aspirations and potential through the support and understanding of their unique learning needs.

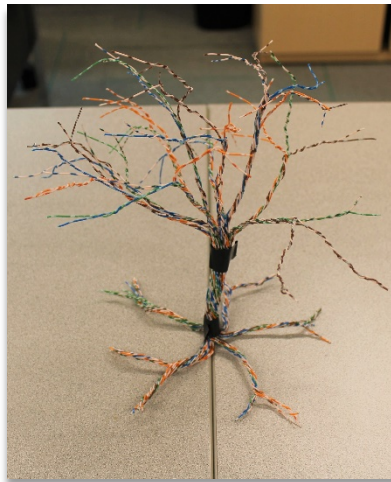
